This fact sheet is to keep residents up-to-date on the Illawarra Coke Company's commitment to minimising the impact of truck movements from Coalcliff Cokeworks

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR COALCLIFF COKEWORKS TRUCK DRIVERS

Rules for trucks entering & leaving the Coalcliff Cokeworks site:

Every truck driver has to undergo an induction which includes the Driver's Code of Conduct; and must complete a questionnaire to demonstrate they fully understand the Code.

- All drivers must abide by the rules and speed limits that have been set by the Roads & Traffic Authority in NSW - this includes, but is not limited to, load limits and driving hours
- All trucks must use the truck wash before leaving the Coalcliff site. Trucks must stop and wait for the truck wash to come on fully before entering it
- Tailgating of trucks is not permitted
- Use of engine brakes is not permitted in Helensburgh, and their use should be minimised in built up areas, especially Coalcliff village
- When it is safe to do so, loaded trucks travelling up Lawrence Hargrave Drive to Bald Hill, must pull over at the top of the hill and let cars pass
- Trucks must be trimmed and free of any loose coke and be fully covered before using the truck wash
- Any coke spillage on roads should be reported immediately
- All trucks must be well maintained and regularly serviced to minimise brake and truck noise
- Coal trucks are not permitted on the Coalcliff site before 9.00am or after 3.00pm
- Coke trucks are not permitted on the Coalcliff site before 7.00am and after 6.00pm Monday to Friday without prior arrangement
- Coal and coke trucks are permitted on the Coalcliff site between 8.00am and 4.00pm on Saturday, but not on Sundays or Public Holidays unless prior arrangements are made by ICC with the EPA
- Drivers are required to rectify any issues before they exit onto the public road.

If a driver does not obey the rules they run the risk of being suspended from the Coalcliff site



Trucking initiatives at Coalcliff Cokeworks

Video surveillance system



- ICC monitors truck drivers' activities on site via a video surveillance system

Coke trucks must be covered before being weighed



- It is every driver's responsibility to ensure their truck is not overloaded

On-site signs reinforce the trucking rules



- On-site signs remind drivers about the Driver's Code of Conduct rules which they must demonstrate they fully understand

A gantry for truck drivers to cover their loads



- There is a designated area and gantry system for drivers to cover and wash their loads safely before leaving the site

All trucks exiting the site must use the truck wash



- All trucks must drive through the truck wash before exiting the site

Warning signs alert road users to trucks turning



- Road signs on Lawrence Hargrave Drive alert drivers that trucks may be turning into or leaving the Coalcliff Cokeworks entrance
