## 'Toucan Arrow' arrives in Japan with ICC's coke shipment

**O**n 26 April 2010 the bulk carrier 'Toucan Arrow' was loaded with an important export shipment of metallurgical coke, produced at the Illawarra Coke Company's (ICC's) Corrimal and Coalcliff Cokeworks.

Bound for Japan, this particular cargo of coke marked the delivery of one million tonnes to major lead and zinc producer Mitsui Mining & Smelting Company between 1986 and 2010.

The 'Toucan Arrow' docked in Port Hachinohe in late May and to coincide with the ship's arrival three representatives from ICC flew to Japan for the occasion.

ICC's Managing Director, Rex Wright, said he travelled to Tokyo and Hachinohe with the company's Chairman, John Horseman, and its Technical Manager, Glenn Benstead, where they presented Mitsui Mining & Smelting & Hachinohe Smelter with gifts to celebrate the delivery of one million tonnes of coke.

"Everyone at ICC is extremely proud to be sending this milestone shipment to a company as large as Mitsui Mining and Smelting Company, as we highly value the business relationship we have maintained with them over 24 years.

"It is also significant for our shipping agents Simpson, Spence & Young, the 'Toucan Arrow' owners Gearbulk

Australasia Pty Limited, logistics services company Lodehaul and the Port Kembla Coal Terminal and we are including all of these Australian companies in our celebrations.

"In Japan, we presented Mitsui's Hachinohe Smelter with two original artworks of Corrimal and Coalcliff Cokeworks painted by Illawarra artist Joyce Wilcock.

"The first set of limited edition prints was presented to Mitsui Mining & Smelting Company in Tokyo.

"A commemorative medallion has also been minted for workers at the smelter in Japan and both of ICC's cokeworks in Australia.

"The delivery of one million tonnes of coke is a landmark for a company the size of Illawarra Coke," Rex Wright concluded.

"It is also testimony to the consistently high quality metallurgical coke ICC produces at its two cokeworks from local Illawarra coal."
